BIOGRAPHY

Prof. IGOR ZANCHI Ph.D. was born in Split 1938. He received the B.Sc. degree in electronics from University of Zagreb, Faculty of Electrical Engineering (FER) in 1962., M.Sc. in 1971. and Ph.D. degree in electronics and radio-communications engineering in 1980.

In 1963. he joined the Faculty of Chemical Technology, Split with primary interest in physics and he worked as research and teaching Assistant. In 1971. he joined Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Mechanical engineering and Naval architecture, Split. In 1999. and 2005. he received academic title of Full Professor in the field of electronics and radiocommunication science. He has been twice the dean of the Faculty, vice-dean, head of the Department of Electronics. Starting with 1998. he is vice-rector of the University of Split, responsible for the education process.

His primary research interests include microwave semiconductor device applications, electromagnetic wave propagation and diffraction. In the same time he is a professor teaching at the graduate and undergraduate studies of Electronics and Communications Engineering.
